SALSA is a peer leadership and mentoring program for students who chose to abstain from alcohol and other drugs. Hannah chooses to refrain from drugs and alcohol because she wants to be a good role model for her younger brother. Hannah joined SALSA as a freshman and quickly became one of the most active club members, she was asked to join the leadership team in her sophomore year. As a part of SALSA, Hannah presents to middle school kids at Pollard, she explains her life choices of not using drugs or alcohol and teaches them refusal skills. She tells students not to let anyone force them to do something they don't want to do and to practice "saying no" before encountering high risk situations.

She also helps recruit new SALSA members at NHS step up day. "I am constantly amazed when I think that Hannah is just a junior in high school, considering all the work she has done to date to help Needham Students stay healthy and safe. " says Karen.
