ATTENTION RESIDENTS OF Rockwood Lane (Bird St to 75' west of Richard Rd)

The Department of Public Works Highway Division will be paving Rockwood Lane (Bird St to 75' west of Richard Rd) the week of May 23rd. (Weather permitting).

Highway Division personnel, as well as town-hired contractor (D&R Paving) will start preparing the streets ahead of paving. First, we will be edging back the loam berm and repairing potholes. Second, we will be raising castings. Finally, a wearing course "top coat" of pavement will be placed. Asphalt low profile curbing will be added in areas to help control erosion in the berm.

After the top coat of pavement is complete driveway aprons affected by the paving will be adjusted. Loaming and seeding of disturbed areas will then follow. This process will take an additional two to three weeks after final pavement has been completed. Please water the newly seeded areas twice a day using a handheld hose early morning and evening to ensure optimal results. Do not park on the new asphalt curb or loam berm as it can be easily damaged.

Please remove any objects that have been placed on the sidewalk or on the loam berm ahead of the construction and identify any irrigation that may be close to the roadway.

We ask residents **not** to park in the roadway and **refrain** from any activity, which could result in water collecting on the roadway during construction and paving operations.

Please take into consideration that paving operations may cause delays in getting in or out of your street\driveway.
